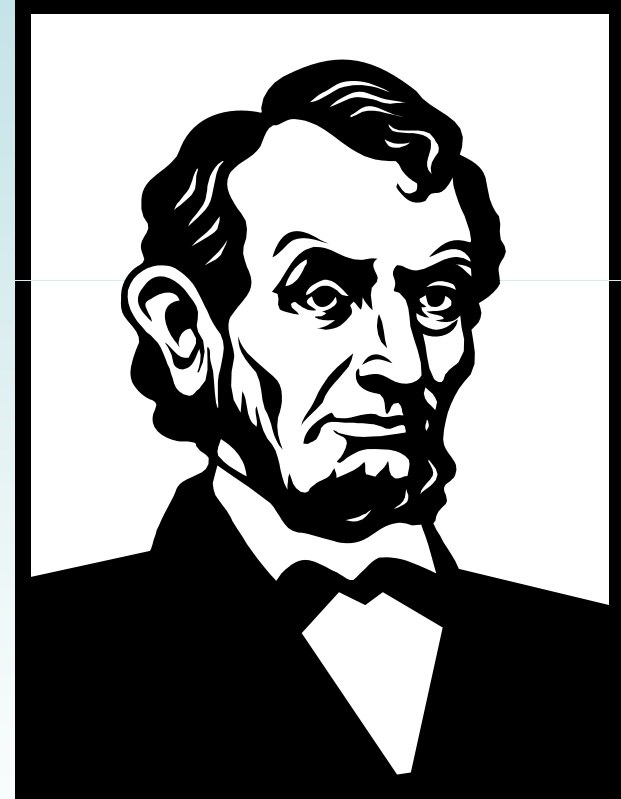

His childhood 😊

- 😊 Lincoln's childhood was rough. His mother died when he was nine and his family moved several times, from Kentucky, where he was born, To Indiana, and then on to Illinois, he had no interest in being a farmer and instead started splitting rails and clearing his father's farm. Then he enlisted in the black Hawk war (a fight to move the Indians westward) as a volunteer. He was elected to lead his company of Soldiers. He later admitted that this gave him more satisfaction than any election he had even won. After the black hawk war, Lincoln did a number of different things.

- 😊 Lincoln's parents, Thomas Lincoln and Nancy Hanks, marry in Washington county, Kentucky, In June 12 1806.
- 😊 Lincoln's sister Sarah is born in Elizabethtown, Kentucky, February 10, 1807.
- 😊 Lincoln was then born in Hardin county (now LaRue county), Kentucky.

- ☺ These are the words Lincoln wrote in his schoolbook when he was a young boy. In this autobiography, Lincoln estimated that his time in school totaled one year. His teachers in pioneer schools in Indiana didn't have any arithmetic textbooks, so Lincoln found some paper which was hard to come by, Tied it together, and created his own "sum book"

His death ☹️

☹️ On the evening of April 14, 1856, While attending a special performance of the comedy, "Our American cousin," president Abraham Lincoln was shot. Accompanying him at Ford's the theater that night were his wife, Mary Todd Lincoln, a twenty-eight year old-old officer named Major Henry R. Rathbone, and Rathbone's fiancée, Clara Harris. After the play was in progress, a figure with a drawn derringer pistol stepped into the presidential box, aimed, and fired. Abraham slumped forward.
