He was given the name Thunder Rolling Down the Mountain, but was widely known as Joseph, or Joseph the younger, because his father had taken the Christian name Joseph when he was baptized at the Lapwai mission by Henry Spalding in 1838*

- As Chief, Joseph looked after his band and friends. Joseph had a father named Tuekakas. He had a family to take care of too. He was married to women named Springtime, the daughter of another chief. They also had a little daughter named sound of running feet.

# *Chief Joseph's education*

- Chief Joseph did not go to school but he did learn many things. His father taught him to fish & also hunt meat. Joseph's father also taught him how to be a very good leader, chief & warrior to protect his troops.

# Joseph's Occupations

Joseph's job is that he is a Chief & a warrior was to protect his people & to send peace with the whites.

# *Joseph's accomplishments*

Joseph fought for freedom to have equal rights as much as any other white man on the earth so Joseph & the nez perces could be treated the same as any other normal person in the united states.

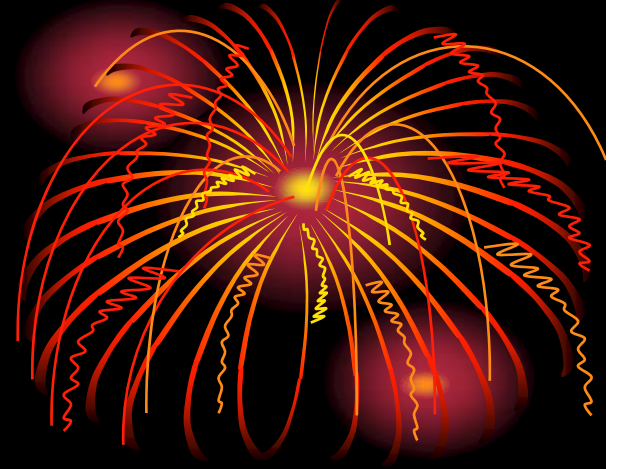
