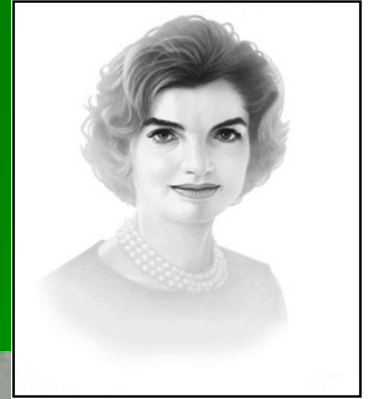


# John F. Kennedy By Bethany Voss

## Education



Other boy joined them, then they started a club called the Muckers! They were often in trouble. Students were not allowed to leave the school grounds without permission.*

## Education Continued

- *But one night, after curfew, the Muckers sneaked out to the local ice-cream shop. While coming back they ran straight into the headmaster (Principal). After graduating his father took him to London. Jack didn't know his father wanted him to attend a summer session at London School of Economics! It WAS published as "Why England Slept". Jack graduated from Harvard and went to join the army! Also during school he was often ill.*

 Jack was a Lieutenant, a hero, and finally our 35<sup>th</sup> President! When he was a lieutenant he worked on PT Boat 109. He had nine crew men! He also was a lieutenant during World War II! During that time he saved one of his men.

- Jack became our President in 1961. He also had two children, a loving wife, and a wonderful home!

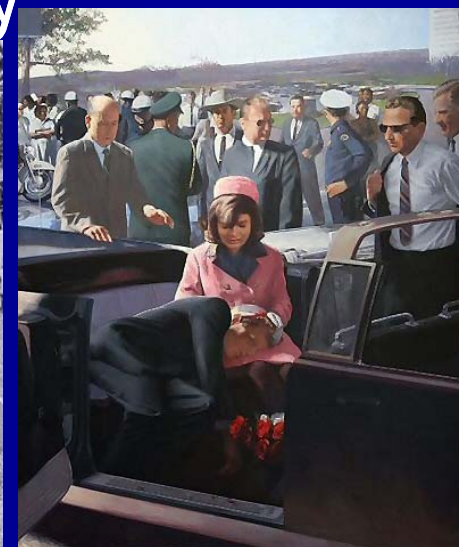


- After Jack's first back operation his brother Joseph died. Also it was hard to have a family that doesn't fit in with other rich family's!
